CHT is now registered with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) as a community-based service for people with mental health problems providing Treatment of Disease, Disorder and Injury (TDDI).

This means that we will now be able to include the regulated activities of psychiatric and social work support into our work with those who come to stay with us: our part-time Psychiatrist and Social Workers will review some incidents or other situations where we feel there is potential for organisational learning, help ensure even better management of health, medication, and casework and move-on planning, and support even better communication with residents' care teams and other external health and social care services.

The current CQC status of our residential communities as Registered Homes remains the same.

This additional registration supports our unique clinical model to enable people experiencing severe mental and emotional distress – including psychosis and personality disorders, and with complex presentations such as self-harm, suicidal preoccupation, delusions, dependencies etc – to fulfil more of their aspirations in life.
